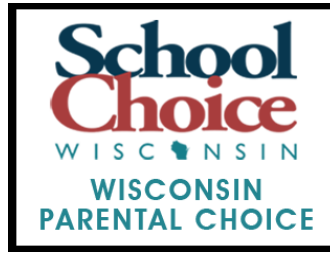

Assumption BVM Catholic School participates in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP), which means eligible students who reside in Wisconsin can attend catholic school tuition-free. Third Source Funding and Service Hours are the other 2 components of the school tuition fee. Families who are eligible for WPCP are **exempt** from all tuition responsibilities (tuition fees, registration fees, Third Source Funding and Service Hours).

To meet the income requirements for the program, a student's family must have an adjusted gross income at or below 220% of the federal poverty level. The **adjusted gross income** can be found on line 11 of your 2020 Federal Income Tax Form (1040). Here are the 2021-2022 income guidelines:

3	\$47,784	\$54,784
4	\$57,640	\$64,640
5	\$67,496	\$74,496
6	\$77,352	\$84,352
*For each additional family member add \$9,856.		

Family Eligibility

- Current WPCP families can register any current 4K through Fourth grade students, and must meet the eligibility requirements.
- Current Assumption BVM School students, *not* previously part of WPCP, who are entering 4K, 5K, and First Grade only can register, and must meet the eligibility requirements.
- New families considering Assumption BVM School can register students in any grade, 4K through fifth, and must meet the eligibility requirements.

When to Apply

- Families need to apply online in order to participate.
- Applications will be accepted from February 1 through April 15, 2021.
- Late applications will not be accepted by the state *for any reason*.

How to Apply

1. Complete the online application.

 - b) An email address **is required** to use the online application.

2. Provide proof of residency to the Assumption BVM School Office.
 - a) Proof of residency paperwork can be a utility bill, cable bill or landline phone bill (cell phone bills are not accepted).
 - b) This paperwork must show the parent's name and correct mailing address.
 - c) This paperwork must be current and dated within three months of the application period.

3. Provide income documentation to the Assumption BVM School Office.
 - a) Income documentation can be a copy of your most recent taxes or W2.

Note: The application and all documents must be received in the Assumption BVM School office by April 15, 2021.
