## Box Tops ~ Final Challenge!

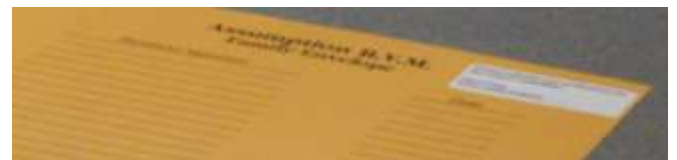
We have had some exciting challenges this year. Our final challenge will be the month of May.
