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## Difference Between Service Hours & Family Activity Hours

### Service Hours

There is a family requirement of 6 Service hours to be met through any of the three options listed below. The 6 hours can be met by doing one of the options, or by a combination of the 3 options. These hours are recorded and must be met in full, or a \$150 fee is assessed.

1. Polka Days Food Stand
2. Rummage Sale
3. Classic Dinner and Auction - TBD

**Note:** Once the required 6 hours are fulfilled, you can work additional hours at \$8 per hour toward your Third Source Funding.

### Jubilee Prayer Card

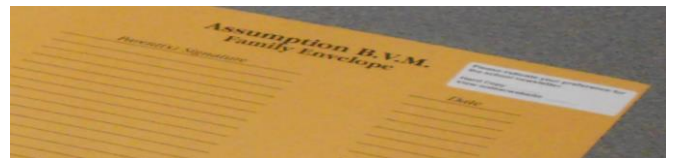
