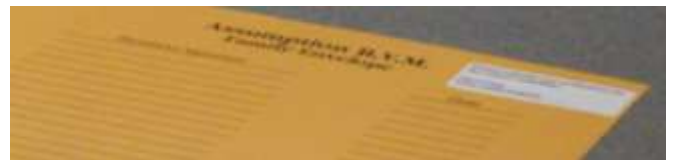
Collective Goods
