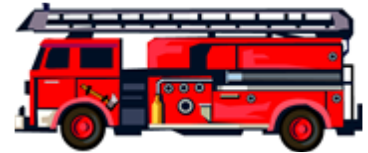

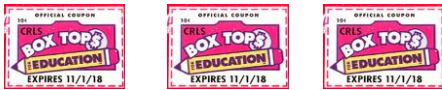

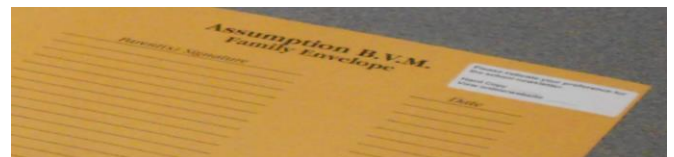
Grade 2 - Journeying Together
