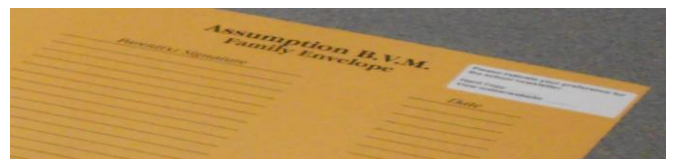


## 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Students
