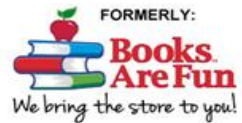

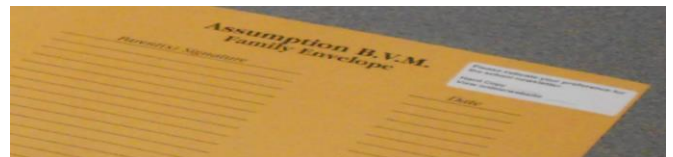
Collective Goods
