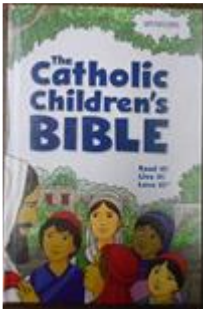

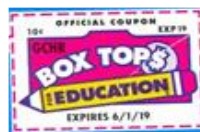
## Christmas Eve Children's Mass

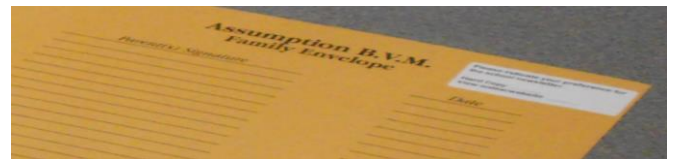


## Advent Season ~ Living the Word
