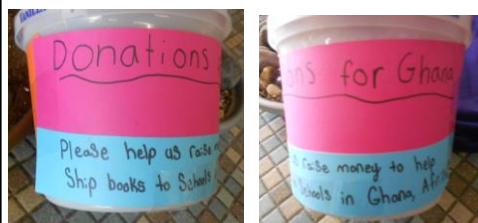
Donations for Ghana
