Parents are always welcome to attend Mass with us. Watch our students take an active part in Mass as altar servers, readers, and singing in the choir.

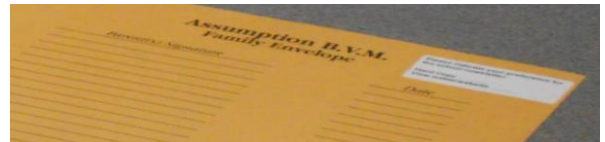
